

PEANUT SEEDS VARIETY KANNA



DESCRIPTION



- ▶ Variety type Valencia
- ▶ Most tolerant to short-term drought
- ▶ Higher oil content, suitable for peanut butter
- ▶ Semi-erect habitus with a bush height of up to 21 cm
- ▶ 6-8 side branches reaching a length of up to 55 cm
- ▶ Pear-shaped leaves with dark green color, attached to short leaf stalks.
- ▶ Cylindrical fruits, attached to short stems, arranged in circles across the bush width
- ▶ 1 to 3 kernels per fruit, mostly 2
- ▶ Round red colored kernels, and up to 85% of them have white stripes
- ▶ Early maturing – 115 days
